

**Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf,
and where applicable, by the following local rules:**

- 1. SLOW PLAY** – All rounds should be played in 3 hours and 58 minutes or less, in accordance with USGA pace rating for El Paso Country Club.
- 2. LIFTING AN EMBEDDED BALL** – Permitted through the green.
- 3. OUT OF BOUNDS** – Marked by the inside edge of the fence posts at ground level of all fences surrounding the golf course and the fence surrounding the driving range, plus the rock walls surrounding the putting green and the rock wall of the swimming pool building. The concrete pillars along #13 and #14 are part of the boundary fence, and are therefore not obstructions.
- 4. OBSTRUCTIONS** – Includes all flower beds and their masonry walls and concrete cart paths. Ball must be played on all other paths. Trees with black tree guard tubing and their tree walls are considered obstructions. Exposed water hoses along the perimeter fence of the golf course, driving range fence and beyond #9 are declared an integral part of the course, thus not an obstruction. (Under Rule 33-2a/1)
- 5. WATER HAZARDS** – Yellow lines and yellow stakes define water hazards. The red lines and red stakes define lateral water hazards.
- 6. GROUND UNDER REPAIR** – All areas defined by white lines and damaged areas caused by skunks. (Rule 33-8/32.5 Local rule treating severe damage by non-burrowing animals as ground under repair.)
- 7. FIRE ANTS** – Fire ant beds are considered ground under repair. If a player feels he/she is in danger, relief is permitted without penalty. Proceed under Rule 25-1b.
- 8. PERMANENT ELEVATED POWER LINES** – If a ball strikes a permanent elevated power line, the stroke shall be canceled and the ball shall be replayed without penalty.
